**LWVCC Hosts Forum on Carlisle School-Related Warrant Articles**

On Thursday, March 11, the League of Women Voters of Concord-Carlisle will hold a public forum at 7:00 p.m. in the Clark Room of the Carlisle Town Hall about the school-related articles on the Carlisle Town Warrant. Those articles deal with (1) the \$20 million Carlisle School Building Project and (2) the \$1.3 million CCHS Feasibility Study and Design Schematics shared with Concord.

The Carlisle School Building Committee has completed the schematic design and will request funding at Town Meeting to complete the project. At the March 11 forum, members of the School Building Committee will update residents on the status of the project and provide details of the proposed addition and renovations to the existing campus building. The forum will also provide residents a chance to ask School Building Committee members questions and provide feedback regarding the project.

The March 11 forum will also feature members of the Concord-Carlisle High School Facilities Master Plan Committee (FMPC), who will discuss their findings, the unique position the Concord-Carlisle Regional School District is in to receive funding from the Massachusetts School Building Authority (MSBA), and the urgent need for a major renovation to transform the existing facility.
